Eligibility



-  Graduate Students Only (Master/Ph.D.)
-  International Students
-  **English-taught** Courses
-  Taiwan Scholarship Recipients Not Eligible

TA's Duties

- **Participation in the TA Training Workshop is mandatory. (The training schedule will be announced separately by the Office of International Affairs.)**
- **Grading multiple choice exams**
- **Grading essay/short answer exams**
- **Grading written assignments**
- **Attending lectures Teaching lab or discussion sections**
- **Other**

Application Process

Students and teachers mutually agree on the TA appointment.

July 21 – July 27,
TA applicants complete the online application.

August 3- August 6,
the instructors should confirm, then OIA will review and select from the pool of candidates.

Important Notes!!

- Applicant can only apply for one course
- Government scholarship recipients are NOT eligible
- The course type and number of students taking the course will be evaluated.



☆ Notice



Scholarship Allocation Priority

- **First priority:** Freshmen who have NOT received the NCHU scholarship.
- **Second priority:** Students from other grades who have NOT received the NCHU scholarship.
- **Third priority:** Other eligible students, with priority given to TAs needed in classes with higher enrollment numbers.
- When the remaining vacancies after allocation reach more than one-fifth, the International Affairs Office may approve a teacher to apply for a second TA for a different course.

☆ Tips



- **Graduate students only**
- **English-taught courses only**
- **Applicant can only apply for one course**
- **Priority to students without scholarships**
- **Priority to courses with higher enrollment**
- **Government scholarship recipients are **NOT** eligible**
